





Cogden Class


Cogden Easter poems

Tremendous trees, grow till brown buds. Flowers are shouting up, with nectar for bees.


Stumbling lambs take their very first steps. Tremendous trees grow as green as grass & tree leaves.

Winter is gone, a new life is here. Dark is gone a new light is here.


Popping pinecones fall to the ground. Shouts zoom up all around.



Bunnies bounce gaily in the open, green space chicks hopping on the growing wheel. While birds keep making a tweet.






lovely lambs, leaping over logs saying

to enjoy the spring sun,



Hysterical Hedgehogs hurrying,

and hugging angry hounds,


brilliant blackberries bumping

DANCES, HAPPY EASTER!!



