
Lateness leaflet:

Every Minute Counts

If you arrive late to school everyday your learning begins to suffer. Below is a graph showing how being late to school everyday over a school year adds up to lost learning time.



If your child is late, when they enter the classroom they will miss the beginning of the day when information is shared that will be important to them. The teacher will outline the day and this will be missed unless there is time to go over the input.

If the initial part of a lesson is missed, the teacher will have to go over the lesson input again taking their time away from other pupils who need help with the lesson activity and your child will have less lesson time too.
