


Q1: As a family we have been able to access lessons successfully.




Q3: Are you happy with the quality of work set in:


Q4: My child has enjoyed the work set.






Q7: I have had contact when needed with my child's class teacher.






Q10: My child has felt anxious about school work at times.


Q11: My child can work independently some of the time at home.


Q12: Have our PE challenges helped your child be active?


Q13: Have you accessed any of the weekly assemblies?

Just a thankyou for all of your hard work

XXX has had to do the work independently as both parents are currently still working majority of the time, I believe she has coped well with organising herself and has said she has completed all her work.

While online learning worked for one child, it hasn't worked for the other. It has been great for a temporary measure but I wouldn't want this to be a new normal. The sooner the children can get back to face to face learning the better it will be for everybody, but we'll done powerstock on your amazing efforts.

The daily structure provided by the regular zoom calls is excellent, thank you! The calls enable the children to manage their time effectively and 'touching base' with the class keeps them motivated throughout the day. My child has mastered the technology and works completely independently while I work from home. Most importantly my child is happy and enjoying the work.

Thank you for all you do

Home school provision from Powerstock has been excellent!

We are working whilst homeschooling so our children are having to be independent. They have a preference to live rather than online. They have struggled with some of it but because they are not having as much support from us as parents as we are in other rooms working. Our children like worksheets and workbooks but I know not all kids do!

Everything has been well provided by school with regards to Remote learning and the teaching has been very good, but there's really no substitute at all for being in the classroom, being amongst peers, and all the rich life and social relationships that school offers.

Most of the work has been extremely well organised and we have really appreciated the ability to email teachers with feedback and also to have the work for the day on PM first thing so we can print out sheets before the start of the day. The days that don't work for us are when Zoom calls are dropped from the timetable or work is not set (i.e. 'catch up on previous work', 'have a rest', 'take a break', 'I'm just teaching X,Y and Z pupils this morning') As working parents this means children are a bit lost on these days (and we also worry that they are getting further behind in their studies). On the whole, though, we have been super-impressed and from speaking to other parents at other schools, the work at Powerstock has been much more structured than most.

There seemed to be a lot of mix ups and the school offered very little help and only replied to emails after weeks of asking for help.

The quality of remote education has been excellent. The mix of live lessons, Oak Academy, YouTube clips, PowerPoint and other resources has been well judged and balanced. The structure of the day is great - hard work, but great, and it has challenged my children to try their best. The Power Maths books have been much better as I haven't had to print much this time and it's been great to have the whole year group working on the same pages together (Y4). The daily contact with their friends and their Teachers has been very important and the additional emailed feedback from Mrs Oxenbury in particular has been extremely helpful. I'm also impressed with the support all the Teachers offer either at the end of live lessons or as an extra 1:1 in the day - it's brilliant! Thank you for all the hard work everyone has put in this half term to make it work!
