Pupils who may not necessarily lead in the traditional classroom setting can become leaders in the forest school setting leading to increased self esteem and confidence. This enhances psychological safety and belonging in school and translates to increased confidence and concentration back in class as evidenced via the individual case studies and Holistic Overview Picture (HoP) for each pupil.

The investment the school chooses to make in swimming is critical as a life skill and is even more important given our coastal location. The impact of the 12 week programme was increased water confidence, swimming skills and life saving techniques.
