- Purchase new iPads and engage Computing professional teaching and CPD for staff.

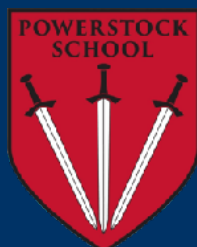
