COGDEN (Y3, Y4)

Developed throughout the 2 year cycle.

Introduce a wider range of genres and authors. Focus on comprehension skills and vocabulary development. Include fiction books like mysteries and non-fiction texts about inventions. Incorporate group reading activities and book reviews.

Encourage reading for pleasure. Introduce book discussions and reading journals. Include historical fiction and non-fiction books about different countries.

Continue to expand reading choices. Include fantasy stories and non-fiction texts about the environment.

SEATOWN (Y5, Y6)

Developed throughout the 2 year cycle.

Focus on advanced comprehension and critical analysis. Introduce a variety of text types, including non-fiction. Include classic novels and non-fiction texts about world history.

Prepare for secondary school reading expectations. Encourage reading across the curriculum. Include fiction books that explore complex themes and non-fiction texts about current events.

Celebrate reading achievements. Organise a reading fair or book swap event. Include a mix of literary fiction and non-fiction texts about future technologies.

This progression plan aligns with the National Curriculum's emphasis on:

- Systematic Synthetic Phonics (SSP): Ensuring a strong foundation in phonics from EYFS through Year 2.
- Reading for Pleasure: Encouraging a love of reading through a variety of genres and authors.
- Comprehension Skills: Developing comprehension and critical thinking skills through diverse texts.
- Fluency and Vocabulary Development: Building fluency and expanding vocabulary with both fiction and non-fiction texts.

This plan ensures that students at Powerstock School will develop strong reading skills and a lifelong love of reading, in line with the National Curriculum guidelines.
