

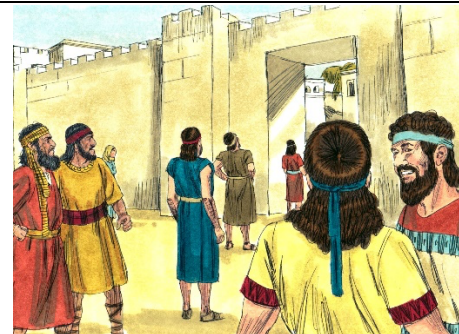
Our value this half term is **PERSEVERANCE**
