French Create a mini-illustrated dictionary of 6 French town words, written beautifully. Geography Design a leaflet encouraging people to prepare for floods. Art Write an acrostic poem using the word typography to explain what it means. Science Count how many electrical items are in your house and make a tally chart.</p>
<p>1 Point Tasks:</p> <p>RE Draw and label one item used during Yom Kippur (e.g., shofar) with a short caption. Geography Write a slogan to persuade people to protect Allerford from flooding. Science Create a shape poem in the form of a lightning bolt using electricity-related words.</p>	<p>3 Point Tasks:</p> <p>PSHE Do one kind thing for someone each day for a week. Write a diary entry at the end of the day describing: What kind thing you did; how the other person reacted, how it made you feel. RE Make a timeline of Yom Kippur events with written explanations and illustrations. French Sketch a map of your local town and label key places and features in French. Geography Create a 3D model of a town that includes features to help manage flooding. Your town could include: buildings raised on stilts or platforms; drainage systems or flood barriers; rivers or water channels; green spaces or trees to absorb water. Art Create a collage using map pieces and typography from magazines. Science Create a maths board game themed around electricity.</p>

Pupils are expected to complete at least 5 points worth of homework over the course of the half term by the deadline.

This can be made-up of any combination of 1, 2, or 3 point tasks.

Pupils who go above and beyond by completing ALL tasks will earn an extra 50 points for their House team!
