1 Point Tasks:

- Orally explain what Christopher Columbus or Neil Armstrong are famous for.
- Use some fruit and vegetables at home to have a go at printing.
- Find as many things as you can that are made of metal in your home.
- Find a recipe book at home and share your favourite thing to eat in it.

2 Point Tasks:

- Design a poster about one of the explorers we have been learning about.
- Have a go at drawing some things that you see in nature (leaves, shells etc.).
- Choose an object in your home and write 5 adjectives to describe it.
- Have a go at cooking with your parents take a photo and share what you did.
- Find out some animals that you might find on the North and South poles you could draw them, make a list or do a poster.

3 Point Tasks:

- Find out information about an explorer that we have not covered (Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong) and present 5 facts on them.
- Create a printing plate using some string and carboard.
- Choose an object in your home and write a paragraph to describe it.
- Write your own recipe for how to make something that you like (this could be a cake or a sandwich or something even more spectacular).
- Make a moving picture of some of the animals that you might find on the North or South poles.

Pupils are expected to complete **at least 5 points** worth of homework over the course of the half term by the deadline. This can be made-up of any combination of 1, 2, or 3 point tasks. Achieving the 5 points will mean the pupil receives 5 points for their House.

Pupils who go above and beyond by completing ALL tasks will earn an extra 50 points for their House team!
