Cogden Power Project – (Autumn 1) Due date: 17.12.25 <u>Units we are covering this term:</u> RE – Christianity – Gospel (Recount) DT – Constructing bridges (Product evaluation) History – Anglo-Saxons (Historical Narrative) Art – Exploring Patterns (Information Poster) Science – Animals and Humans (Newspaper Report)	2 Point Tasks: RE - Write a first-person recount titled “I Was There at the Birth of Jesus”. DT Build the longest bridge you can using only paper and tape! History – Write a short story about the life of an Anglo-Saxon child. Art - Take photos of patterns from around your home or garden and present them in an interesting way. Science – Draw and label the main bones and muscles in a human body.
1 Point Tasks: RE – Make a 3D model of the nativity scene DT Produce a fact-file sheet about famous bridges. History – Create an illustrated poster showing the daily life of Anglo-Saxons Science -. Make a healthy living poster showing how humans stay healthy (diet, exercise, hygiene).	3 Point Tasks: RE – Make a chart comparing how Matthew and Luke tell the Christmas story. DT – Produce an illustrated poster showing different types of bridges (arch, beam, suspension). History – Create a 3D model of an Anglo-Saxon village. Art - Make an information poster titled ‘All About Pattern’ Science - Write a newspaper article titled “Amazing Discovery About Humans and Animals!”.

Pupils are expected to complete at **least 5 points** worth of homework over the course of the half term by the deadline.
This can be made-up of **any combination of 1, 2, or 3 point tasks.**
Pupils who go above and beyond by completing ALL tasks will earn an extra 50 points for their House team!
