<p>Seatown Power Project – (Summer 1) Due date: 20.5.26</p> <p><u>Units we are covering this term:</u></p> <p>Geography: National Parks (formal recount – ranger focus) Science: Light (information poster) Art: Fashion Design (design + explanation) RE: Islam – Hajj (news report) PSHE: Rights, Responsibilities & Growing and Changing (reflection/diary)</p>	<p>2 Point Tasks:</p> <p>Geography: Write a short formal recount titled: “A Morning in the Life of a National Park Ranger”. Try to include: fronted adverbials, formal tone, real ranger jobs Science: Create a mini information poster explaining ONE of the following: Reflection, Refraction, The spectrum (rainbow). Include a diagram with labels. Art: Create a fashion inspiration board using drawings, colours, textures or materials. Add annotations explaining where your ideas came from. RE: Write a news report paragraph explaining one key ritual of Hajj and the value it shows (e.g. equality or devotion). PSHE: Create a fact vs opinion poster using real-life examples (news, school, social media). Clearly label which statements are facts and which are opinions.</p>
<p>1 Point Tasks:</p> <p>Geography: Label a map of the UK showing at least 3 National Parks we have studied. Add one natural feature for each park. Science: Create a labelled diagram showing how light travels from a source to your eye. Use arrows and at least 3 scientific words. Art: Design a simple clothing item (top, jacket, skirt or trousers). Colour it carefully and label at least 2 design features. RE: Write a short paragraph explaining what Hajj is and why it matters to Muslims.</p>	<p>3 Point Tasks:</p> <p>Geography: Write a full formal recount titled: “A Day in the Life of a National Park Ranger”. Include: paragraphs, fronted adverbials, technical vocabulary, clear sequencing of events. Science: Design a full information poster about LIGHT including at least 4 sections (e.g. how we see, reflection, refraction, colour, shadows). Include labelled diagrams and precise scientific vocabulary. Art: Design a complete fashion outfit inspired by nature, pattern or movement. Present: a coloured fashion illustration, clear labels, a written explanation of your design choices and purpose. RE: Write a full news report explaining what Hajj is, what happens and why it matters to Muslims today. Use a formal, neutral tone as if writing for a newspaper. PSHE: Write a reflective diary entry about change, responsibility or growing up. Try to include: emotional vocabulary, clear paragraphs, careful punctuation for effect.</p>

Pupils are expected to complete at least 5 points worth of homework over the course of the half term by the deadline.

This can be made-up of any combination of 1, 2, or 3 point tasks.

Pupils who go above and beyond by completing ALL tasks will earn an extra 50 points for their House team!
